FUN FACTS & ACTIVITIES FOR KIDS

Fun Facts about Twin Falls:

Twin Falls is located in the “Magic Valley.” Do you think that the town is made up of people doing magic tricks? Well, it became magical in a different way.

Irrigation projects (watering the land) turned dry places, where nothing could grow, to farmland which provided food to eat. People said this was magic.

The city may sound as if it has two waterfalls because it has the word twin in its name. It really has three waterfalls: Shoshone Falls, Pillar Falls and Twin Falls. They are beautiful.

Children's Activities:

Talk to your children about why plants need water to grow. Explain that water is what feeds the plant. If their soil is dry, they will not grow.

Growing plants can be magic for your child. Give him/her seeds to plant and water. Then watch the magic!

Make more magic . . . Let your child pick a place in your garden that he/she will take care of to make sure it is watered. If you have indoor plants, give your child the responsibility of checking the soil to make sure the plants are well fed.

Teach your child to measure the growth of the plants on a weekly basis. You can then chart the magic together. Growing charts are also great for measuring the “magic” of your child's growth and encouraging healthy eating.
