SPONGE PAINTING

AGES 3-5

MATERIALS

- ★ Household sponges
- * Paper plates or bowls
- **★** Scissors

- ★ Washable tempera paint
- * Large sheets of paper

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut different shapes (such as circles, squares, and triangles) out of household sponges using scissors. You can also leave some sponges whole for larger stamping surfaces.
- 2. Pour washable tempera paint into paper plates or shallow containers, using a different color for each container.
- 3. Dip the sponge stamps into the paint, ensuring that they are evenly coated but not dripping.
- 4. Encourage the children to stamp the painted sponges onto large sheets of paper to create colorful patterns and designs. They can overlap shapes and experiment with different combinations.
- 5. Once they're finished, allow the paintings to dry completely before displaying or handling.
