## TAPE RESIST PAINTING

## SCHOOL AGE

## **MATERIALS**

★ White paper or canvas

\* Washable tempera paint

**★** Water cups

★ Masking tape

\* Paintbrushes

**★** Paper towels

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Use painter's tape or masking tape to create shapes or designs on paper or canvas, ensuring edges are firmly pressed down.
- 2. Once the tape designs are in place, let children freely paint using the tempera paint over the taped areas and experiment with blending, gradients, or texture.
- 3. Encourage painting right up to the edges of the tape for clean lines and bold contrasts.
- 4. If desired, children can use stencils or cutouts to add additional shapes or designs to their paintings.
- 5.Once paintings are complete, allow them to dry thoroughly before carefully peeling off the tape to reveal the white areas underneath.
